NAMING FOSTERS

When choosing a name for your foster cat/kitten, please check the 'Do Not Use Animal Name List' in the 'Volunteers Only Page'. It becomes very confusing when we have cats/kittens with duplicate names EVEN if they are spelled differently or a number added to the name. So choose a name NOT on this list.

MEDICATIONS

Please see the 'Foster-Given Medication Tracking' in the 'Volunteers Only Page'.

SPAYING/NEUTERING

Schedule spaying/neutering for kittens/cats by texting Nadi request a date, it will be a Wednesday. On the date your given, take the kittens/cats to Nadi's house (14 Mile and M-5) by 6:30am. The will be taken to All About Animals from there. The next day (Thursday), you will need to be at Nadi's for pickup 8-8:30am. Please wait out from until you see that days driver in Nadi's driveway.

READY FOR ADOPTION

When your foster cats have had all vaccines, dewormer, flea treatment, microchip, combo testing, and have been spayed/neutered, they are ready for adoption. Use the Kitten OR Cat Adoption Info Form link in the '**Volunteers Only Page'** on <u>www.locrami.com</u>. When writing a bio or taking photos to be used on our website please read and follow guidelines in the 'Adoption info (BIOS) for posting cats' documents in the 'Volunteers Only Page'. Great pictures and a detailed bio are extremely important to help our kitties get adopted. A fellow volunteer will post them on the website within a few days. When a potential adopter inquires about the cat, a LOCRA Adopter Rep will interview them and decide if they are a good fit and will contact you for a meet and greet with the cat if they are approved.
